1. Policy

2:120

This new policy reflects the changes in the law regarding mandatory Board training.

2:200

This policy is updated on the open meetings act and the audit.

4:110

This policy is updated to clarify the transportation of homeless students.

4:170

There are several updates to the safety policy including changes in the sex offender reporting, movable soccer goals and law enforcement drills.

5:10

This policy adds pregnancy, childbirth or related medical conditions to a protected class.

5:220

This policy for substitute teachers reflects the changes in Public Act 97-607.

This policy reflects the legal changes for student teachers.

This policy adds drug and alcohol testing of bus drivers.

6:50

This policy reflects the changes as a result of the Hunger-Free kids act.

This policy clarifies eye and dental exams.

7:190

This student discipline policy changes language related to the internet and alternative programs.

7:270

Reflects the changes in self-administration of medication with auto-injectors.

## 2. Finance

We are still awaiting the response from the Village regarding TIF monies. The money can be used as matching funds for renovation projects if needed. The priority is to update technology for both building. We are on target to finish the year in the black and continue to extend our reserves.

## 3. Transportation

The parent letter intended to announce reducing the bus route at Parkview is planned for the end of March or beginning of April. The walk to school campaign will begin with this shift with the hopes of gradually reducing bus travel for all students not on a dangerous route. The Building Council just met to explore ideas to encourage parents to walk with their children and to carpool.

Quotes are now being received for projects for the District office. I am working with DCEO to receive additional money for the lighting upgrade in all the buildings. To honor the time limits set forth in the grants we will complete the work in stages.
